

**A book about Bobby Brodsky, *un artiste extraordinaire*. His life story is told using 100 full color reproductions of his drawings, 84 photos of both family and his other art forms, 40 poems, a playlist, and his sister's memories.**

The dazzlingly colorful and wonderfully weird drawings by Santa Fe artist Bobby Brodsky, who passed away in 2012, form the centerpiece of this memorial volume produced by the artist's sister.

A playful spirit and joyful outlook pervades Bobby's life and work beginning with his early years on a small North Valley farm in Albuquerque, youth in Claremont, California and

Honolulu, with sojourns in San Diego and Paris, France followed by art school in Oakland, California.

After graduating he settled in La Cienega, New Mexico where he established Rabbit Artworks, a ceramic art and pottery business with Tina Davila, his college girlfriend, wife, and mother of their three boys.

The book chronicles his travels, successes, defeats, revivals, loves and losses, his constant work and restless creativity. It is the story of a guy who never stopped working, making art, musing, writing, and spreading his strange and inspiring ideas.
